


Below is a map displaying research sites for the Adolescent Brain and Cognitive Development (ABCD) Study, the largest long-term study of brain development and child health in the United States. The project will recruit 10,000 healthy youths and follow them into early adulthood to determine the effects of many biological and environmental factors on brain development, health, and other outcomes, such as academic achievement. Displayed here are the project coordinating center, data analysis and informatics center (flags), and the research sites where the study will be performed (dots).
